The research is to be related to the main collecting areas of the Fondation Custodia / Frits Lugt Collection, namely that of European drawings and prints ("art on paper"), illustrated books from the sixteenth till late nineteenth centuries, *plein air* oil paintings and autographs.

Location is The Hague. The <code>Jacoba Lugt-Klever Fellow</code> is required to submit a publishable scholarly text after completion of the fellowship.
